

## Maths

The children will develop their counting skills. We will focus on counting, recognising and ordering number to 10 and onto 20. We will practise writing numbers and learn to match objects to numbers. We will begin to explore more and less and begin to identify 1 more and 1 less than a given number. The children will learn to recognise a variety of 2D shapes and they will explore using 2D shapes to make pictures.

## Literacy

**Phonics:** We will be introducing Jolly Phonics to the children. They will learn 5 sounds a week which will be in their reading records each week. The children will be learning to write the letters for the sounds and the letters in their names. We will be introducing reading to the children.

**Writing:** The children will learn to form letters correctly to write their names and other simple words using their phonic knowledge.

**Books we will be using:** Twinkle, Twinkle, little star, Green egg and ham, Each, Peach, Pear, Plum, The Enormous Crocodile and using a variety of nursery rhymes to base our learning around.

## R.E

**Myself:** The children will know and understand the importance of names and that God knows and loves me and each one by name.

**Welcome:** The children will know and understand what it is to welcome and be welcomed and will also learn about baptism and that it is a welcome to God's family.

## Expressive arts and design

The children will explore using different materials to create clay stars. They will explore pattern making and collage making.
