

Maths

The children will explore numbers to 5 through practical activities, songs and stories. They will begin to recognise numbers of personal significance. They will develop their understanding of number and their 1:1 correspondence when counting groups of objects.

The children will explore basic 2D shapes and begin to recognise and name shapes in their environment. They will explore a variety of resources to make shape pictures and complete simple puzzles.

Literacy

Phonics: The children will explore phase 1 activities, playing a variety of games and completing activities that support their ability to recognise different sounds in their environment. The children will be supported to begin to recognise their own name and through a range of activities explore the letters in their names.

Writing: The children will explore mark making using a variety of resources, through both adult led and independent activities the children will be encouraged to talk about and give meaning to the marks they make.

Books we will be sharing: Kipper's Birthday, Elmer, Owl Babies, Titch, Polar Bear Polar Bear, From Head to Toe and The Enormous Crocodile.

R.E

Domestic Church-Family: The children will explore the Topic 'Myself' in which they will begin to understand that they are different from each other, that we are all precious to God and he loves each one of us.

Baptism/Confirmation-Belonging: The children will explore the Topic 'Welcome' in which they will begin to explore the importance of being welcomed, how we can welcome others, how it makes us feel. They will explore baptism and how we are welcomed in to God's family.

Expressive arts and design

The children will explore different materials to create their own Elmer's for the Elmer's day parade, owl babies and Enormous crocodiles.

They will have lots of fun role playing in home corner role-play area, and looking after the babies.

Understanding the World
