

Maths

Children will consolidate their **number** and **place value** skills.

They will **add and subtract** up to 2 digit numbers using number lines, partitioning and concrete and pictorial representations.

Children will learn table facts or the 2, 5 and 10 **times tables** and understand the inverse relationship between **division, multiplication** and repeated addition.

Literacy

Fairy tales: Children will be familiar with a number of fairy tales especially Little Red Riding Hood. They will discuss the common elements found in them to help develop their understanding of the features of fairy tales. They will plan and write their own fairy tales.

Ourselves: Children will read The Ahlberg's Funnybones which will support their use of grammar and punctuation in their writing.

Children will have 1 phonics lesson a week.

Beginnings: Knowing God is present in every beginning.
Signs & Symbols: The holy signs and symbols used during Baptism and their meaning.

Visitors/Advent: Preparing to celebrate Christmas.

One other faith: TBC.
