

### Maths

In Maths we will continue to deepen our understanding of fractions and make links between decimals and percentages. We will learn about Ratio & Proportion in the context of recipes. In Geometry we will learn about angles, two & three dimensional shapes and co-ordinates.

### English

We will be reading a range of extracts from classic texts and using these to write in a range of genres. We will be working on improving our self-editing and proof reading skills. We will also be revising the grammar and punctuation we have been learning and applying this in our writing.

### R.E

We follow the Come and See programme of study for R.E. Our first topic is Sources and we will be looking at how the bible is the story of God's love. We then start the Unity topic looking at how the Eucharist enables people to live in communion.

### Science

In Science we will begin an exciting topic called 'Everything Changes.' In this topic we will be looking at why living things vary, how things have adapted to survive and why certain animals have become extinct. We will continue to build on our knowledge of how to conduct scientific experiments and learn how to display data in a range of interesting ways.

### Topic

In History we will be looking at Kings and Queens of the British Monarchy, specifically aiming at answering the "the big questions" (debating). In Geography we will use a range of maps and geographical information systems to gather, interpret, analyse events during different monarchies. In Art we will be examining portraits of past kings and queens, as well as creating our own in the style of Danny Warhol.
